Strategic Plan Update

Superintendent Dr. Paul Hertel shared that the action teams have all met to address the five of the [13 strategies](#) that were named as priorities this year. Work has begun to analyze the goals and

determine how the district can improve its focus for the future.

In addition, Dr. Hertel introduced Dr. Charlene Myklebust who has served as a consultant to support the district as it focuses on social emotional learning support for children.

Student Performance Monitoring - District 62 Assessments Including PARCC, DLM and ACCESS

Director of Strategic Initiatives and Accountability Victorene King, Assistant Superintendent for Student Services Dr. Ellen Swanson, Director for Second Language Learners Milagros Bravo and Director of Community Relations Jennifer Tempest Bova provided the Board of Education with an overview regarding 2018 student assessments that include Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers (PARCC), Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) and ACCESS (English language acquisition). In addition, the presentation focused on the federal legislation, Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) and how the district will communicate updates to staff, families and community about ESSA and its implications as well as how the district will move forward with this new evolving legislation. 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2018 Tentative Levy Process Update

The Board will adopt the Tentative Levy at the November 19 board meeting and authorize the publication of a Public Hearing Notice. The Public hearing is scheduled for December 17, 2018. The Board adopts the Levy that evening following the Public Hearing. Administration will file the 2018 Levy with the County Clerk prior to December 26.

Operations Fund Monies Transferred to Debt Service Fund

As required in the Illinois Program Accounting Manual (IPAM), the long-term debt service payment may be made from the Debt Service Fund. The District does not intend to levy in the Debt Service Fund to pay the debt obligations related to the 2009 Bond issuance. The amount of the transfer requested in the 2018-2019 Budget is \$8,360,747.00.

The Board of Education approved the transfer.
